## **Domestic Manual Rollers**

Your roller requires care and maintenance to achieve maximum life and to uphold the warranty. The following are recommended maintenance steps:

- 1. Do not store chemicals close to rollers.
- 2. Keep all castor wheels clean and free of debris (e.g. hair).
- 3. If the roller is in a pit or a box, it is important to keep the area free of debris that could interfere with the operation of the roller.
- 4. To ensure the durability of your pool cover, it is advisable to smooth out any sharp edges on the pool coping where the cover is connected to the roller. These edges can potentially cause damage to the underside of the cover when it is being deployed or retracted.
- 5. Rollers can be cleaned down with a cloth and if in an indoor environment sprayed with a clear anti-corrosive spray.
- 6. Do not stand or sit on the roller tube.
- 7. Where rollers are installed or stored indoors, be sure to keep the area well-ventilated.
