


Sunbather Winter Covers Installation Guide



How to Install

To complete the installation you will need:

- · Tape measure
- · Drill with hammer function
- · 3/8 Masonry Drill Bit



- 1. Lay the cover flat over the pool.
- 2. Attach the attachment cords if not already done at 500 600mm intervals.
- 3. Using care, drill at 500-600mm intervals around the pool cover, approx 500mm from the pool edge. Certain types of paving chip easily and will not require the hammer function on your drill.
- 4. Clean the dust from the drill holes and insert the sleeves into the paving or pool surrounds. Tap them in lightly with a hammer.

Once the sleeves are in the pool surrounds, follow the diagrams below:

- 5. Drop the stainless steel screw into the sleeve (A). You do not need to screw them in.
- 6. Start by circling the pool and pulling the cords approximately 90% tight. Then complete another lap of the pool and tighten again to ensure the cover is suspended.







Care & Maintenance Guide

A Winter Cover requires care and maintenance to achieve maximum life and to uphold the warranty. The following are recommended maintenance steps:

- 1. When off the pool, always store the cover in the special bag provided out of direct sunlight and in a cool dry place.
- 2. Before folding and placing in the bag, allow the cover to dry.
- 3. To prevent cover damage, do not drag over abrasive pool surrounds or sharp surfaces
- 4. If necessary tension the cords to ensure your cover is suspended above the water.
