
# Step 1. Prepare the covers

assembling/installing product

- 1. Identify both ends of the thermal cover that will be connected using the eyelet hinge.
- 2. Ensure that both covers fit appropriately on the pool. Confirm that no further trimming is required before proceeding to the next step.


#### Step 2. Mark the outer holes 0 0






- Measure 35mm in from the edge of the cover.
- Measure **75mm** in from the end of the cover.

### Step 3. Mark additional holes 0



- 5. Determine the number of additional holes needed, ensuring they are evenly spaced, no more than 600mm apart, and 35mm from the cover's joining edge.
- 6. Mark the hole locations on both covers, ensuring they are parallel for consistent alignment.

## Step 4. Punch the holes 0 0 0


- **7.** Place a piece of protective backing (such as timber or plastic) underneath the cover to prevent damage to paving or decking.
- **8.** Then take the metal punch supplied and using a hammer, tap the bevelled end of the punch into the marks you previously made on the cover.

#### Step 5. Attach the eyelet

- **9.** Place the male half (flange side) of the blue plastic hexagon eyelet through the holes from the top side of the cover. Fold the edge of the cover over to expose the underside 3 13.
- **10.** Snap the female half of the eyelet onto the male half, and gently tap them together with a hammer until secure ①.
- 11. Repeat for all holes.

## Step 6. Attach cords to create the hinge

- **12.** Fold the 2 pieces of thermal cover together, so that the male sides of the eyelets are on the inside and the female sides are facing outwards **0**.
- **13.** Thread a 4mm cord through the opposing eyelets and secure it with a knot, ensuring the loop is not too small .
- **14.** Repeat this process for all eyelets, making sure each loop is the same length to create a consistent and secure hinge for the pool cover.
- **15.** These steps should leave the knot position underneath the cover, hidden from view. (See front cover image.)
