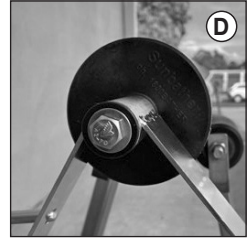
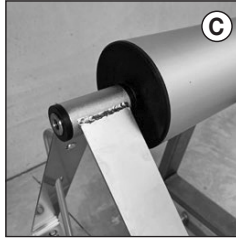
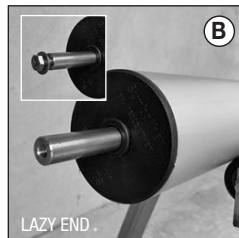
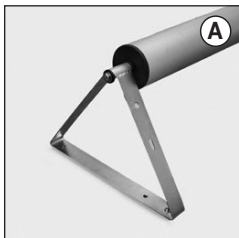
1 X ROLLER TUBE

Section 3. How to Assemble Roller

1. Identify the Drive (E) and Lazy end (B) of the roller.
2. Determine which side of the roller you would like the handle to be on. This must use the drive end of the roller which has a hole for the handle (E).
3. Check the roller tube is wider than the pool. Ideally 150mm on each side. Please see diagram on following page.
4. Ensure the side of the end frame with the holes in it is closest to the water. (A).
5. Remove bolt and washer at lazy end of the roller tube (B).
6. Thread tube into bushes of end frame (C).
7. Refit bolt and washer, then tighten with 17mm spanner (D).
8. Repeat the above steps to fit end frame to drive end of roller tube (E).
9. Insert crank handle through hole in drive end of tube and tighten bolt onto flat surface of crank handle with 17mm spanner (F).
10. Position the roller so that the end frames are equally spaced from the sides of the pool and align the roller parallel to the end of the pool, so it is just off the water.



Section 4. Operation Guide

4.1 Putting the cover on the pool

- Remove security strap from around the cover and clip around the leg of the roller for safe keeping.
- Ensure both drop pins are in place to secure the roller (if you have purchased a upgrade kit).
- Pick up the haul cord and walk to the other end of the pool.
- Pull the cover onto the pool.
- Put the haul cord on top of the end of the cover.

4.2 Removing the cover from the pool

- Wind the crank handle to begin winding up the cover. Note if there is a hinge section you need to fold the hinged piece onto the main cover and then under roll not over roll
- Once the cover is completely on the roller, fasten the security strap around the cover to stop it from unwinding/self shedding.

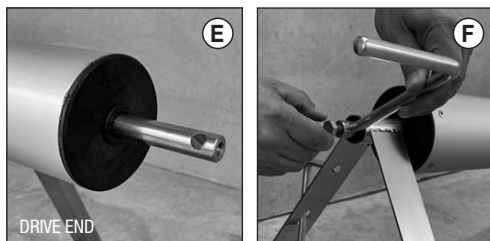
NOTE: As this roller does not have drop pins or lockable castor wheels to fix it's location during operation, please take care in slowing pulling the cover on and off the pool.

In cases of strong winds and inclement weather please ensure your cover is off the pool and secured on the roller.

Section 5. Care & Maintenance

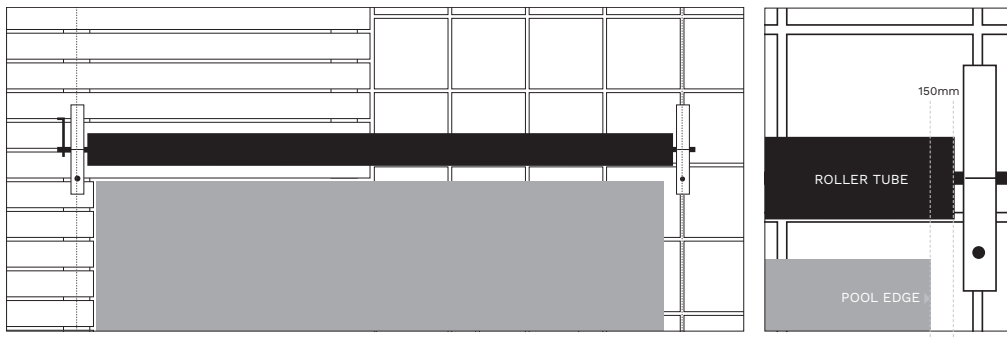
Your roller requires care and maintenance to achieve maximum life and to uphold the warranty. The following are recommended maintenance steps:

- Do not store chemicals close to rollers.
- Keep all castor wheels clean and free of debris (e.g. hair).
- Rollers can be cleaned down with a cloth and if in an indoor environment sprayed with a clear anti-corrosive spray.
- Do not stand or sit on the roller tube.
- Where rollers are installed or stored indoors, be sure to keep the area well-ventilated.



5.1 Coverroll Ground - Install Guide

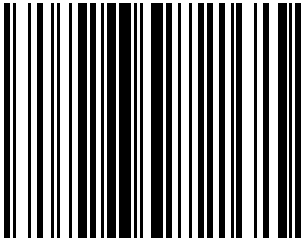
5.1.1 How to Assemble Roller



Refer to the relevant guides for cover and attachment installations

TIP: Ideally the roller tube should be positioned as close to the edge of the coping as possible. This positioning helps the cover lift up and directly onto the roller. Setting the roller too far back creates unnecessary drag and can cause the frames to tip forward.
